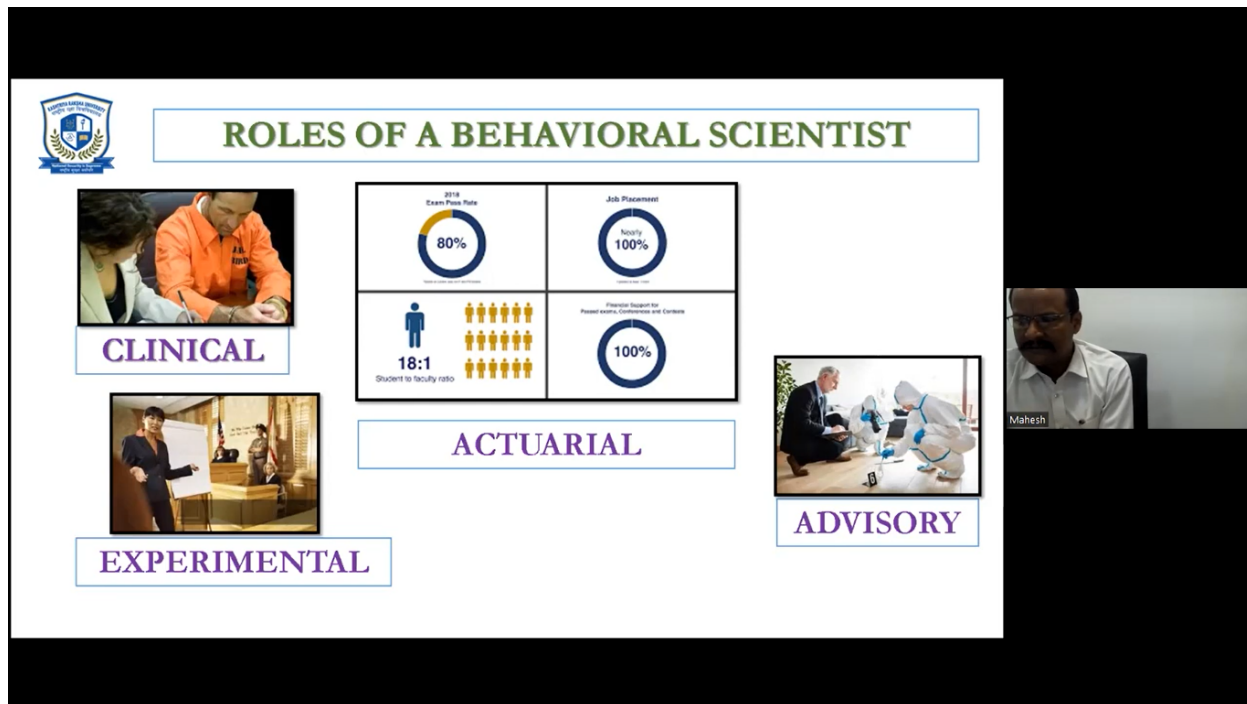
Objectives of the Webinar
