Subject: Online Counseling for admission to Master’s degree programmes through AIEEA-PG-2017 examination held on 11th June, 2017.

Dear candidate,

Based on the result of the ICAR's 22nd All India Entrance Examination (AIEEA-PG-2017), for admission to Master degree programmes in agriculture and allied sciences for 25% seats in accredited Agricultural Universities i.e., SAUs, CAU, BHU, AMU, Visva Bharati and Nagaland University and 100% seats at IARI, IVRI, NDRI, CIFE and Dr. RPCAU Pusa, Bihar in the Academic Session 2017-18, this is to inform that **you have qualified for theonline Counselingto be conducted by the ICAR** as per the schedule givenbelow. Based on the online Counseling, you are likely to be recommended for admission in the accredited subject and accredited University of your choice, subject to fulfilling the eligibility conditions of that University and availability of seats at your merit rank and category. The university will place the candidates in accredited colleges only. The SC/ST candidates who do not wish to take admission in their respective reserve category, may opt for counseling with General + OBC category provided they meet the prescribed eligibility criteria of General category.

Before participating in online counseling, you must ensure that all the eligibility conditions, as specified in the AIEEA-PG Information Bulletin (IB) available on www.icar.org.in/www.icarexam.net, are fulfilled in toto including completion of the degree, OGPA/percentage marks scored in Bachelor’s Degree examination, etc. (Where OGPA is awarded, equivalence between OGPA and % marks will not be acceptable). The candidate is advised to read the IB in detail and especially the Item 9.0 (Method of Selection and Admission through Online Counseling) of AIEEA-PG IB and the requirements contained therein.

The candidates should note that having 4/5(B.V.Sc.& A.H.)/6(10+6, B.Sc. Ag.) years’ UG degree is the essential requirement for admission to Master degree programmes. The candidates having passed with 3 years’ UG degree programme are not eligible for admission through AIEEA-PG-2017 except at IARI and NDRI.

The exact title/nomenclature of the degree programme might vary from one university to another. The candidate is advised to enquire about the nomenclature of degree programme and other details from the Registrar of the concerned university [for contact details, please refer Annexure-VIII of the AIEEA-PG IB] before registering for online counseling/seeking admission.

To get ICAR- PG Scholarship, the candidate must pursue Master’s degree from an AU in a state different from the one where the AU of his /her Bachelor’s degree is located, i.e. AUs of Bachelor’s degree and Master degree should be located in different states. This condition, however, shall not apply for admission to NDRI, Karnal where admissions to 100% seats of Bachelor’s degree programme are made on the basis of All India Entrance Examination conducted by ICAR.

The non- PG Scholarship/NTS(PGS) candidates shall be eligible to get National Talent Scholarship (NTS) of Rs. 3000/- per month for two years provided they join Master degree programme in an AU located in a state different from their state of domicile. Even the candidates who do not want to avail NTS(PGS) have to mandatorily seek admission in an AU different from the one from where they have graduated.

The award of PG scholarship and NTS (PGS) shall be governed by the rules and regulations issued by the Council from time to time in this regard. After the admission, under no circumstances, the request for change of subject and the university will be entertained from the candidates/parents.

It may be noted that ICAR/University will NOT be held responsible for denial of admission to non-eligible candidates.

Online admissions close on 31-07-17. No more online allotment will be done. If some seats still remain vacant then Universities will fill them on their own.	

The candidate may please note that the online counseling portal will be available for registration, choice filling and saving the choices from 07.07.2017 to 11.07.2017. The candidate is advised to carefully go through the major steps involved in Online Counseling delineated below.

Before exercising the option of choice filling, the qualified candidate will have to get registered by paying Rs. 2,000/- through online payment gateway of ICAR by using Credit/Debit card/Net banking. The candidate must lock the choices on or before the deadline. If the candidate fails to lock the choices on or before the deadline, contents of the form as provided by the candidate on the portal will get locked automatically after the deadline.

Registrars of all the concerned accredited Universities have been intimated regarding the Online Counseling and granting admission. Your original certificates may be required to be deposited with the Registrar. In case of late reporting by the candidate for admission in the allotted university due to any reason(s), he/she will lose claim for admission and no correspondence shall be entertained by the Council in this regard.

The list of original documents with self-attested photocopies, photographs to be produced at the time of admission in the allotted University may be referred to under Item 9.1(iii) of the IB.

Ragging in the Universities, in any form, is a criminal offence and has been strictly banned.

Please note that this letter is for information of the candidates desirous of registering for counseling and does not, in any way, guarantee the admission.

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Major steps in Online Counselling

Entrance test for UG / PG / PhD



Declaration of results of entrance test



Downloading of Counselling letter



Online Choice Filling as per declared schedule



Candidates who have qualified for counselling have to login and register for counselling by visiting www.icar.org.in or www.icarexam.net by using the same User ID and Password used while filling up of online application. Candidate's details, which will play role in seat allotment, will be displayed. Candidates who had filled their status as “**Appearing**” (at the time of online application submission) will be mandatorily required to fill marks/OGPA obtained in qualifying exam. Candidate has to pay one-time non-refundable registration fee (Rs 2000) through Online payment gateway using Debit/Credit card or Net banking



Candidate should select his/her preferred **Course and University** from Dropdown Menus.



Choice filling will be permitted only during 1st round of counselling. Candidates can add/delete/modify their choices any number of times between 07-11th July, 2017. The choices will automatically get locked after **11:59 PM on 11.07.2017**. For 2nd/3rd round of counselling, allotment will be done on the basis of same choices filled earlier (If candidate is not allotted any seat earlier).



For UG, only those course(s) will be displayed in which the candidate is eligible. **For PG**, candidate will be able to select the sub-subjects within the Major Subject as filled in online application form.

For PhD, both Major and Sub-subject as filled in online application will be displayed.



Only accredited Universities, where the desired accredited courses run, will be displayed. However, candidate should cross check the same from the concerned University.



Candidate can fill maximum number of choices **as per his/her preference/order**, as this will be an important criterion for seat allotment.



On the date of allotment, candidate's choices, his / her merit, score, qualification, domicile, last University in which he/she studied and seat matrix will be processed together and seat will be allotted with/without scholarship/fellowship. Reservation rules (except PC category, 5%) as prescribed in the respective Information Bulletin will be followed.



Downloading of provisional admission recommendation letter containing the Course / University allotted and the reporting dates on which he / she has to visit the allotted University. Candidate will also be sent this intimation through SMS and e-mail.



On visiting the allotted University, candidate has to produce all relevant original documents to the University officials. They will verify the documents. Then candidate has to pay the prescribed admission fee, after which the University will generate admission letter.



In the event of not getting their first choice, candidates may be allotted subsequent choices of their preference. If the seats fall vacant, allotment will be made as per the candidate's choice/preference only on request to the university for **auto-upgradation**. Candidates are advised to take admission in their allotted seat and opt for auto-upgradation, if they desire so.



University may refuse admission if documents are not found in order.



University will allot any accredited college to the candidate, on their own discretion at a later stage.
College allotment will not come under the scope of this counselling.



University will online report about the admission status of each candidate, individually. Seats remaining vacant will form the seat matrix for subsequent rounds.



2nd and 3rd round of allotment will be done for the candidates who failed to get seat in the 1st and 2nd round, but choices will remain the same as filled earlier.
