NCC Wing Enrolment at Balangir

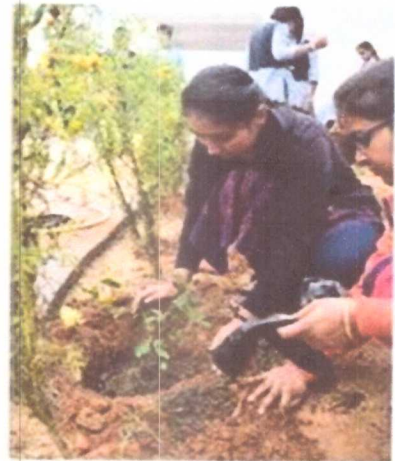

For the celebration, we had the following competitions as per the below mentioned details to increase awareness of the importance of Innovation.

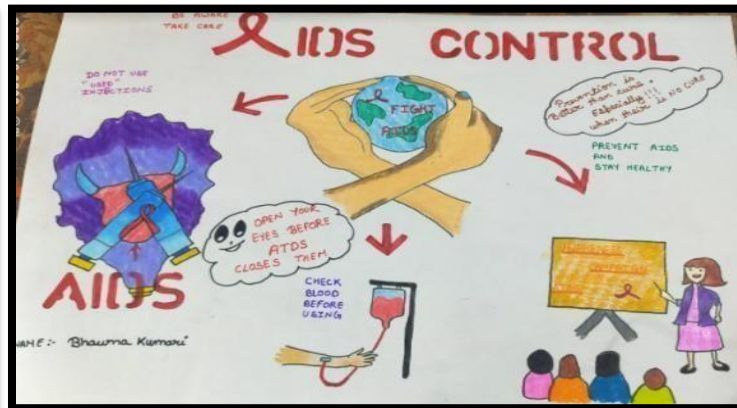
Theme was "Ending the HIV/AIDS Epidemic: Resilience and Impact".

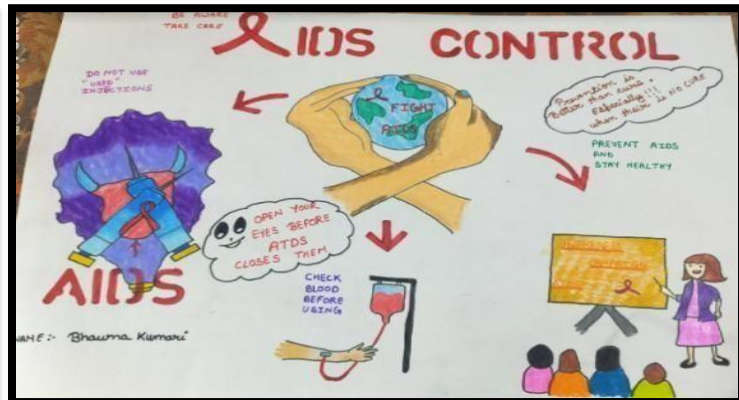
4. Observation of World AIDS Day on 1st December 2020

The role of OSACS in reducing the spread of the disease was also highlighted by him. In the technical session, the detailed facts of HIV & AIDS were shared by Dr. Bijay Behera, Technical Expert, CST. A memento to Dr. Anita Patra as a token of appreciation from Lepra to CUTM was presented by Ms. Jyotsna Sahoo. The inaugural session was ended with a vote of thanks from Prof. Kulabhusan Pradhan. Then there was a quiz test conducted for the audience on the HIV & AIDS awareness. All the students who were given the first right answer got a coffee mug as an appreciation. All the participants did a ribbon game and were tied RED RIBBON to each other as a symbol of celebration of the day. Then an oath to spread the message of awareness among others and living healthy and letting others to live healthily was taken by all the participants. Then we had been a messaged writing and signature campaign to spread awareness on the issue. Finally, we had been a candlelight showed at the rangoli made for the cause.
