Subject: Online Counselling for admission to Master's degree programmes through AIEEA-PG-2018 reexamination held on 18thAugust, 2018 and 16th September, 2018 (in Kerala).

Dear candidate.

Based on the result of the ICAR's 23rd All India Entrance Examination (AIEEA-PG-2018), for admission to Master degree programmes in agriculture and allied sciences for 25% seats in accredited Agricultural Universities i.e., SAUs, CAU, BHU, AMU, Visva Bharati and Nagaland University and 100% seats at IARI, IVRI, NDRI, CIFE and Dr. RPCAU Pusa, Bihar in the Academic Session 2018-19, this is to inform that **you have been found eligible to register (online) for choice filling.** You are likely to be recommended for admission in the accredited subject and accredited University based on your choice, subject to fulfilling the prescribed eligibility conditions and availability of seats at your merit rank and category. The university will place the candidates in accredited colleges only. The SC/ST candidates who do not wish to take admission in their respective reserve category, may opt for counseling with General + OBC category provided they meet the prescribed eligibility criteria of General category.

Before participating in online counseling, you must ensure that all the eligibility conditions, as specified in the AIEEA-PG Information Bulletin (IB) available on www.icar.org.in/www.icarexam.net, are fulfilled in *toto* including completion of the degree, OGPA/percentage marks scored in Bachelor's Degree examination, etc. (Where OGPA is awarded, equivalence between OGPA and % marks will not be acceptable). The candidate is advised to read the IB in detail and especially the Item 9.0 (Method of Selection and Admission through Online Counseling) of AIEEA-PG IB and the requirements contained therein.

The candidates should note that having 4/5(B.V.Sc.& A.H.)/6(10+6, B.Sc. Ag.) years' UG degree is the essential requirement for admission to Master degree programmes. The candidates having passed with 3 years' UG degree programme are not eligible for admission through AIEEA-PG-2018 except at IARI and NDRI.

Candidates reporting for the admission in the allotted university must have final year/ final semester result in hand clearly indicating final OGPA/CGPA or final percentage of marks where grade points are not awarded. Candidates will be required to produce Provisional/Degree certificate of qualifying graduate examination issued by the university for this purpose. The candidates who do not have the PDC/Degree certificate, have to mandatorily produce a certificate from the Registrar of the concerned university specifically indicating that the candidate has fulfilled all the requirements for the award of Bachelor degree. His/her Final OGPA/Percentage of marks at the end of final semester/year along with likely date of issuance of PDC/Degree must be mentioned. The candidates should note that the university may deny admission in case the PDC is not produced at the time of admission at the university. No correspondence shall be entertained by the Council in this regard.

The exact title/nomenclature of the degree programme might vary from one university to another. The candidate is advised to enquire about the nomenclature of degree programme and other details from the Registrar of the concerned university [for contact details, please refer Annexure-VIII of the AIEEA-PG IB] before registering for online counseling/seeking admission.

To get ICAR- PG Scholarship, the candidate must pursue Master's degree from an AU in a state different from the one where the AU of his /her Bachelor's degree is located, i.e. AUs of Bachelor's degree and Master degree should be located in different states. This condition, however, shall not apply for admission to NDRI, Karnal where admissions to 100% seats of Bachelor's degree programme are made on the basis of All India Entrance Examination conducted by ICAR.

The non- PG Scholarship/NTS(PGS) candidates shall be eligible to get National Talent Scholarship (NTS) of Rs. 3000/- per month for two years provided they join Master degree programme in an AU located in a state different from their state of domicile. Even the candidates who do not want to avail NTS(PGS) have to mandatorily seek admission in an AU different from the one from where they have graduated.

The award of PG scholarship and NTS (PGS) shall be governed by the rules and regulations issued by the Council from time to time in this regard. After the admission, under no circumstances, the request for change of subject and the university will be entertained from the candidates/parents.

It may be noted that ICAR/University will NOT be held responsible for denial of admission to non-eligible or late reporting candidates due to any reasons.

Schedule for online counseling:

The candidate may please note that the online counselling portal will be available for registration, choice filling and saving the choices as per schedule. The candidate is advised to carefully go through the major steps involved in Online Counselling delineated below.

Before exercising the option of choice filling, the candidate will have to get registered by paying Rs. 2,000/- through online payment gateway of ICAR by using Credit/Debit card/Net banking. The candidate must fill the choices on or before the deadline. The contents of the form/choices as filled by the candidate on the portal will get locked automatically after the deadline.

Auto up-gradation will be permitted only in the first round since there are only two rounds of counselling.

Those candidates who scored zero or negative marks in the offline entrance examination held on 18th August, 2018 or 16th Sep 2018 (in Kerala) are not eligible to participate in counselling.

Those candidates who did not fill their qualifying exam marks till the designated date and whose status of qualifying exam is still "Appearing" are not eligible to participate in counselling.

Note:- Scholarship / fellowship allocation will be done after three days from closing of Last Date of reporting of last round.

The list of original documents with self-attested photocopies, photographs to be produced at the time of admission in the allotted University may be referred to under **Item 9.1(iii) of the PG IB**

Registrars of all the concerned accredited Universities have been intimated regarding the Online Counselling and granting admission. Your original certificates may be required to be deposited with the Registrar. In case of late reporting by the candidate for admission in the allotted university due to any reason(s), he/she will lose claim for admission and no correspondence shall be entertained by the Council in this regard.

No claim or compensation for problems (if any) encountered or cost incurred in counselling/admission will be entertained by the ICAR/ Universities.

Procedure / Major steps in Online Counselling

Entrance Examination for PG admission Declaration of result Downloading of Counselling letter Online Choice Filling as per declared schedule Candidate who has been found eligible for choice filling should login and register for counselling Candidate's details, which will play role in seat allotment, will be displayed. Candidate has to pay one-time registration fee (Rs 2000) through Online payment gateway. Candidate should select his/her preferred course and University from drop down menu. Choice filling will be permitted only once. For subsequent round of counselling, allotment will be done on the basis of same choices (If candidate is not allotted any seat till then.) For PG admission and award of both Major and Sub-subject as filled online will be displayed. Only those accredited Universities will be displayed where the desired courses run. However, candidate should cross check the same from the concerned University. Candidate should fill maximum number of choices but give utmost importance to preference/order/serial number of his/her choices as this will be an important criterion for seat allotment.

On the date of allotment, candidate's choices, his / her merit, score, qualification, domicile, last University in which studied and seat matrix will be processed together and seat will be allotted.

Reservation rules will be followed.

Downloading of provisional allotment letter containing the Course / University allotted and the dates on which he / she has to visit the allotted University with all necessary documents. Candidate will also be sent this intimation through SMS and email.

On visiting the allotted University, candidate has to produce all relevant original documents to the University officials. They will verify the documents. Then candidate has to pay the admission fee in cash. Then University officials will generate provisional admission letter.

Some candidates will be allotted their 2nd, 3rd or higher choice. On the other hand, some seats allotted to other candidates may remain vacant due to non-reporting. Now these candidates may desire that in the subsequent rounds of allotment, they should be shifted to their better choice, if seat(s) have become vacant. Such candidates should request the University officials to online mark them for "Auto-Upgradation" However they have to first take admission on their allotted seat. In the subsequent round of allotment, these candidates will be tried for their better choices on these vacant seats which have become vacant due to not reporting. If they get a better choice, then OK otherwise their initial allotted seat will remain with them. Auto-Upgradation is permitted only in the first round. University may refuse admission if listed documents are not found in order.

University at a later stage will allot any accredited college to the candidate, on their own discretion.

And it does not come under the scope of this counselling.

University will online report about the admission status of each candidate, individually. Seats remaining vacant will form the seat matrix for subsequent round.

Subsequent round of allotment will be conducted on candidates who did not get any seat in the earlier round. But choices will remain same as filled in the beginning.
