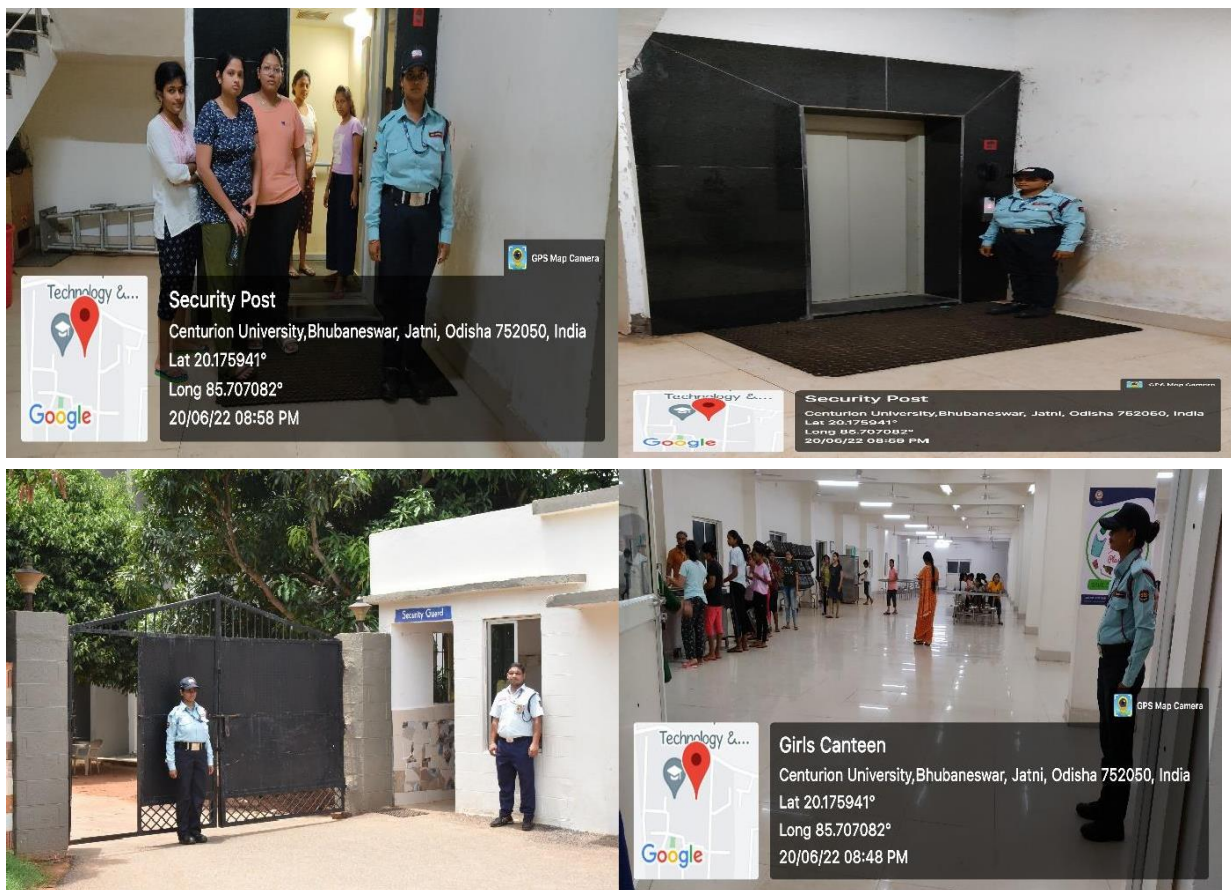


Fig: Women Security guards in girls hostel, Paralakhemundi and BBSR campus

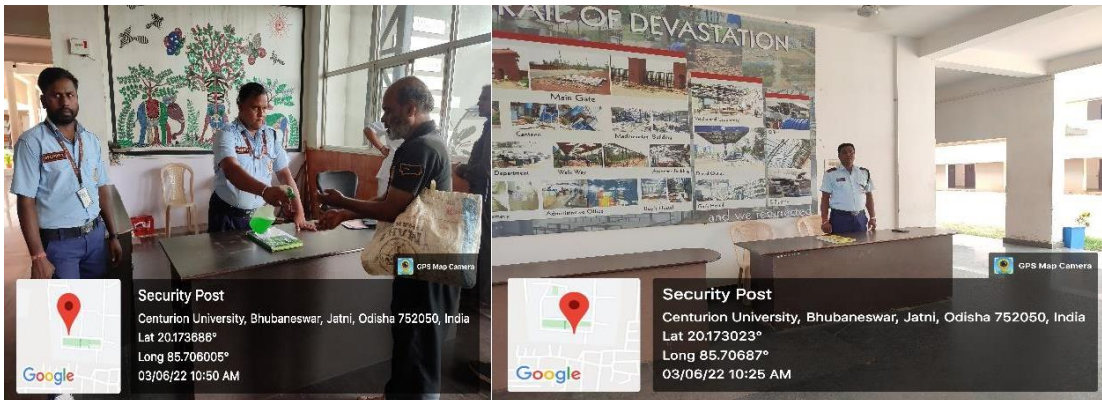

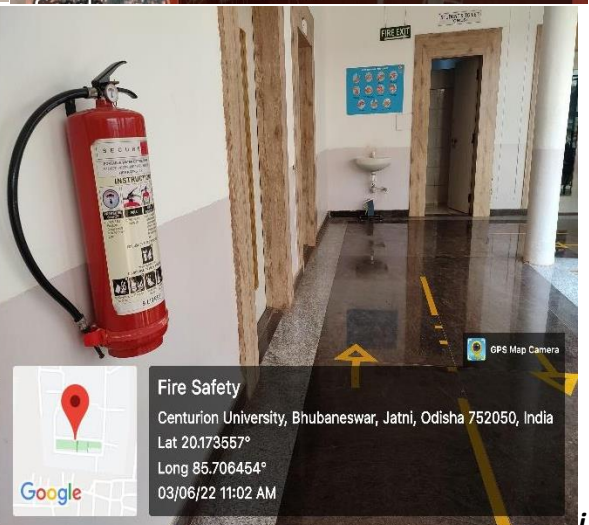

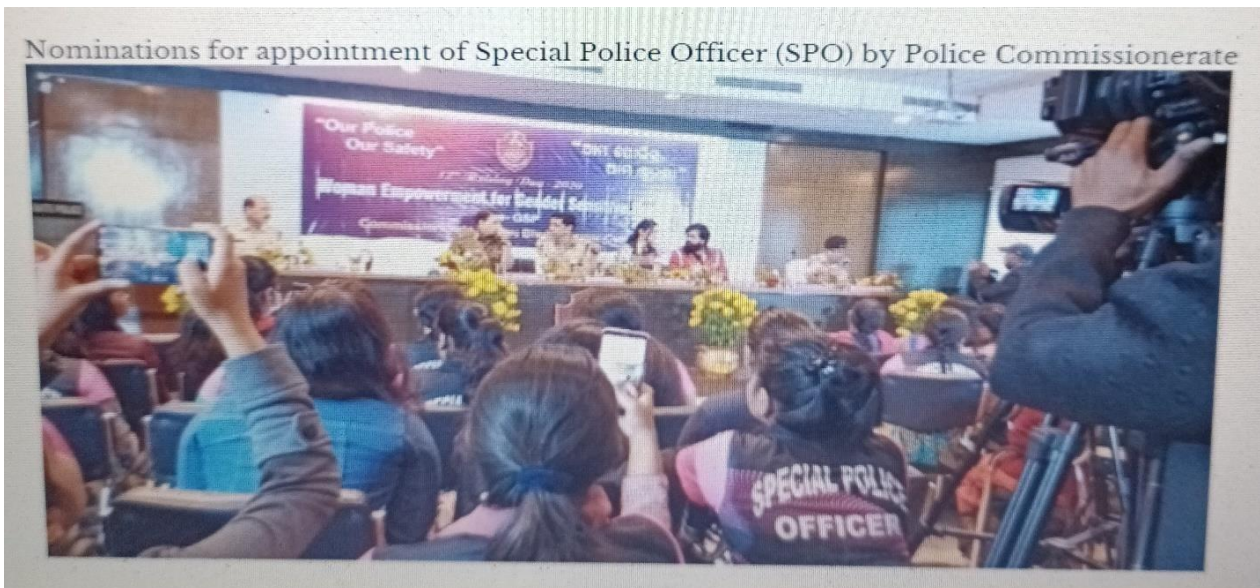


Fig: Special Police Office (SPO)
