

The University has notified a policy on Academic Integrity and Anti-Plagiarism. It has also procured the Turnitin anti-plagiarism software and made it available for the use of all students and faculty. The software is available with the Library and Research Coordinators and PhD Cell. Urkund software, as promoted by the University Grants Commission may also be used by anyone who desires to do so. All PhD thesis and other publications have to mandatorily use Turnitin and keep the similarity levels below 15% or as per the guidelines of the publications.
