After a numerous defeat and demise of the king Gajapati Mukunda Dev, who is the founder of chalukya dynasty and the last king of the Odisha state in 1568.Due to which Odisha state lost its political identities and also the independence.

To regain pleasure Odia people rebellion withinside the management of Utkala Gouraba Madhusudan Das, Utkala Mani Gopabandhu Das, Maharaja Krushna Chandra Gajapati, Pandita Nilakantha Das, Fakir Mohan Senapati, Gangadhar Meher, Basudeba Sudhaladeba, Radhanath Ray, Bhubanananda Das, A. P. Patro and lots of others. They established Utkal Sammilani and fought for a long time and their attempt resulted withinside the formation of a politically separate nation beneath British rule on linguistic foundation on 1st April 1936.

The newly shaped Odisha consisted of six districts as Cuttack, Puri, Baleswar, Sambalpur, Koraput and Ganjam having its capital in Cuttack. John Austin Hubback was the first who took oath of workplace and have become the primary Governor of Orissa Province.




