

6.5.1 Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) has contributed significantly for institutionalizing the quality assurance strategies and processes by constantly reviewing the teaching learning process, structures & methodologies of operations and learning outcomes at periodic intervals.

Response:

IQAC maintains and analyses monthly information reports related to the teaching and learning process, structures and methodologies of operations and learning outcomes. At the outset, IQAC ensures that the course material is prepared to keep in pace with global technological advances and the expected standards (that is, it is reviewed by internal and external experts and also peer reviewed) and is available in the public domain (courseware.cutm.ac.in) for use by students. Course preparedness sessions are conducted for each and every subject in each department and school. The institutionalisation of quality assurance strategies and processes is vide classes being regularly monitored by a faculty/non-teaching staff to assess that they are conducted properly and that the attendance of students is ensured. Further, all University examinations are conducted by a Quality Assurance Cell, which is located outside the University premises.

Two practices that have been institutionalized as a result of IQAC initiatives are a) mentoring with a view to help the students with their career progression and b) introduction of skill courses and practice components in courses to improve learning outcomes and enhance employability.
