ABOUT THE CLUB:

The Animal Club is a student-driven club formed Centurion to take care of the stray animals. The aim is to aid to the strays (dogs, cats, cows - and any other injured/ suffering animals) within the Campus and surrounding areas.

It will also help identify the animals externally and keep them protected as well as create awareness about helping animals – which may be replicated soon by other neighboring colleges/ institutions.
- > Build a shelter for the animals. Land will be requested from Centurion University.
- Appoint staff for regular cleaning of the area, and care for the sick, injured, undergoing treatment animals, etc.

- Organize events to raise awareness about animal-protection and encourage people to live and promote a cruelty-free lifestyle.
- Adoption: People can adopt the animals from the campus. However, as a safety measure for the animals, interval home checks would be mandatory; we would love to ensure that our animals have found a loving and safe home! We will also allow virtual adoption of the animals i.e., people can adopt an animal without having the need to take them home, they would help by providing financial support for that particular animal whom they wish to adopt. A third method would be for students to adopt animals on Campus and care for them while they are on the Campus. This would include, feeding, walking, medical treatment, and generally loving them to bits.
