## **ABOUT CSR PROGRAMME**

It is part of our curriculum that all students of Centurion University of Technology and Management will now be required to participate in the Culture, Sports, and Responsibility (CSR) program during their studies at CUTM w.e.f. 2011-12 academic year. The program gives students an opportunity to learn from the experience of doing real tasks beyond the classroom, related to Culture (student life/creative pursuits), Sports (activities for Physical Fitness) and Responsibility (activities for the benefit of the community or the environment).

Each student is required to complete a total of 30 hours of CSR activities each academic year\*. This should include 10 hours of Culture, 10 hours of Sports and 10 hours of Responsibility. After completing of an activity, the Faculty supervisor must sign this record booklet. Only students who have completed the required hours (each activity will be minimum of 1 hour and maximum of 8 hours) of CSR, are eligible to pass that academic year.

At the end of the Centurion University degree, the CSR grade will be reflected in the final Grade Sheet and the student will receive the CSR Booklet listing all of the CSR activities he has completed. This can be used for his/her Resume. Information about student clubs, meetings, including details of Faculty-In-Charge, their contact, and CSR updates are displayed on the CSR Activity Information Board on campus. Student can ask any faculty member to supervise the activity and sign the CSR Booklet indicating that the hours have been completed.

## **TYPES OF ACTIVITIES**

Students are strongly encouraged to plan and initiate their own ideas, and collaborate with other students to create projects they find interesting and worthwhile. The activities below are merely examples. Generally, projects should be pre-approved by the chosen supervisor.

Examples of "Culture" activities:

- Working on CUTM student Newsletter, Wall Magazine, and Annual Magazine,.
- Organising/participating in dance, music or drama events.
- Preparing artistic works (e.g. murals) for beautification of CUTM.
- Participating in any event organised by the clubs under cultural activities.
- Painting and Photography etc.....

Examples of "Sports" activities:

- Participating in individual and team sports of the Institute
- Taking part in sporting expeditions.
- Participating in Health Club/Yoga Club.

Wishing You all a Happy Utkala Dibas – Odisha Day @ 1st April!

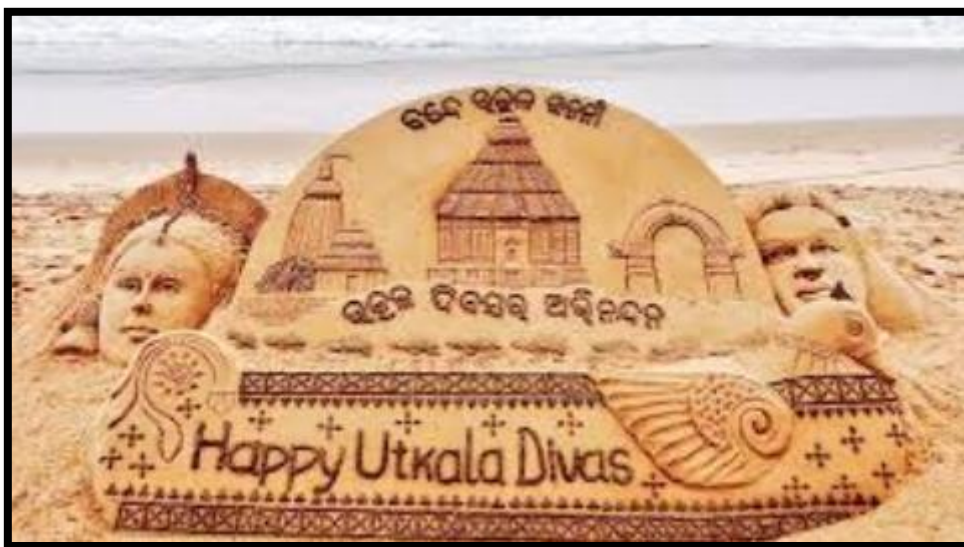
Odisha Day (Utkala Dibas) is celebrated on 1st April in Odisha in the memory of the formation of the state as a separate province (Swatantra Pradesh) on 1 April, 1936. After losing its complete political identity in 1568 following the defeat and demise of the last Hindu king Mukunda Dev, Odisha lost its complete political identity in 1568.

To regain our pride Odia people revolt in the leadership of Utkala Gouraba Madhusudan Das, Utkala Mani Gopabandhu Das, Maharaja Krushna Chandra Gajapati, Pandita Nilakantha Das, Fakir Mohan Senapati, Gangadhar Meher, Basudeba Sudhaladeba, Radhanath Ray, Bhubanananda Das, A. P. Patro and many others. They founded Utkal Sammilani and fought for three decades and their effort resulted in the formation of a politically separate state under British rule on linguistic basis on 1st April 1936.

The newly formed Odisha consisted of six districts as Cuttack, Puri, Baleswar, Sambalpur, Koraput and Ganjam having its capital in Cuttack. John Austin Hubback took oath of office and became the first Governor of Orissa Province.

This Year we were not able to observe the Day on campus due to the lockdown. Let us think about the sacrifices made by our ancestors being at home.

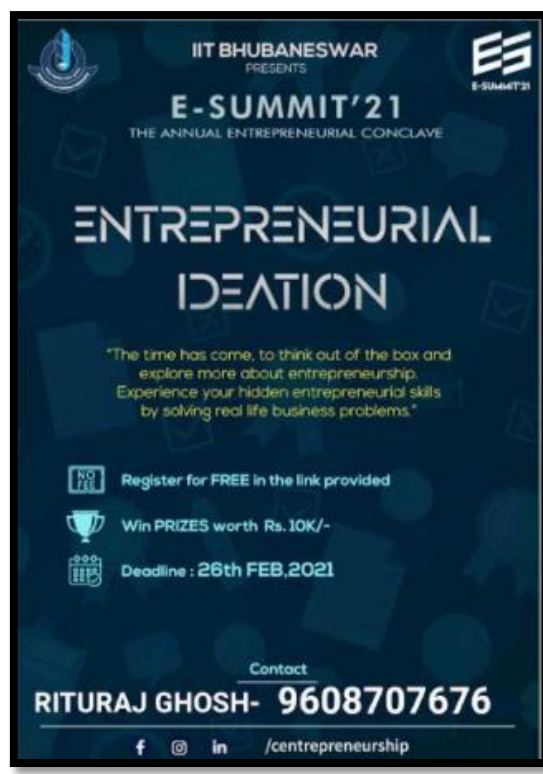
### **E Summit 2021 IIT Bhubaneswar on 25<sup>th</sup> Feb 2020**

## **Happy Utkala Dibas: ଉତ୍କଳ ଦିବସ – Odisha Day: ଓଡ଼ିଶା ଦିବସ @ 1st April 2021**

The 85th Foundation Day of Odisha (Utkala Dibas: ଉତ୍କଳ ଦିବସ) is celebrated in Centurion University, Bhubaneswar Campus.

Odisha Day (Utkala Dibas) is celebrated on 1st April in Odisha in the memory of the formation of the state as a separate province (Swatantra Pradesh) on 1 April, 1936. After losing its complete political identity in 1568 following the defeat and demise of the last Hindu king Mukunda Dev, Odisha lost its complete political identity in 1568.

To regain our pride Odia people revolt in the leadership of Utkala Gouraba Madhusudan Das, Utkala Mani Gopabandhu Das, Maharaja Krushna Chandra Gajapati, Pandita Nilakantha Das, Fakir Mohan Senapati, Gangadhar Meher, Basudeba Sudhaladeba, Radhanath Ray, Bhubanananda Das, A. P. Patro and many others. They founded Utkal Sammilani and fought for three decades and their effort resulted in the formation of a politically separate state under British rule on linguistic basis on 1st April 1936.

The newly formed Odisha consisted of six districts as Cuttack, Puri, Baleswar, Sambalpur, Koraput and Ganjam having its capital in Cuttack. John Austin Hubback took oath of office and became the first Governor of Orissa Province.

This Year also we were not able to observe the Day physically on campus due to the Govt. restrictions for COVID-19. Let us think about the sacrifices made by our ancestors being at home. Feel proud to be an Odia.

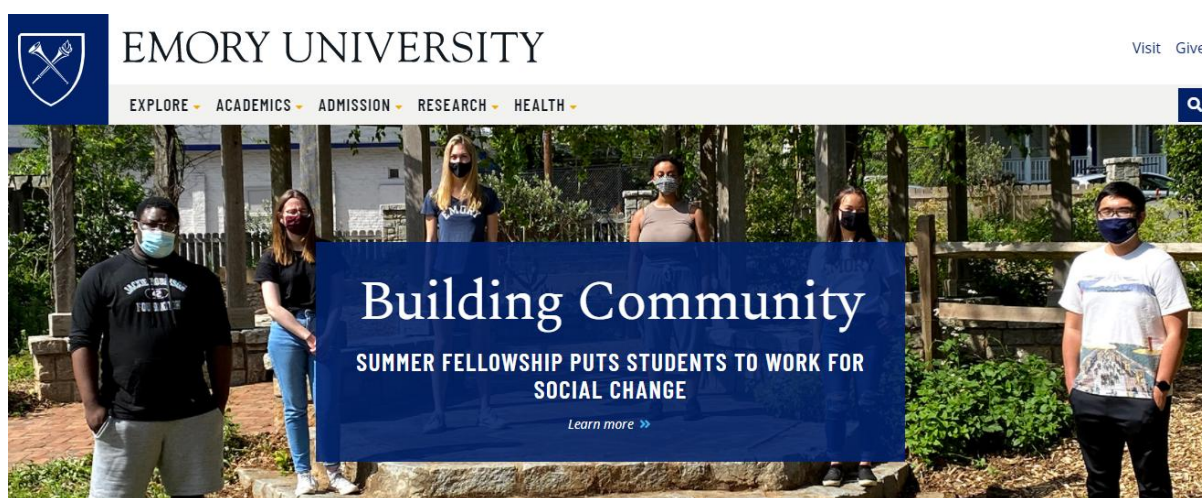
### **Background on Study:**

The unsafe disposal of child feces into backyard area of households or in ponds and other bodies of water causes fecal contamination of the environment and may lead to diarrhea and other illnesses. As such, Emory University is working with the NGO Gram Vikas to evaluate a behavior change intervention aimed at improving child feces management practices (i.e. promoting the disposal of child feces into the household latrine and teaching children to learn how to use the latrine).

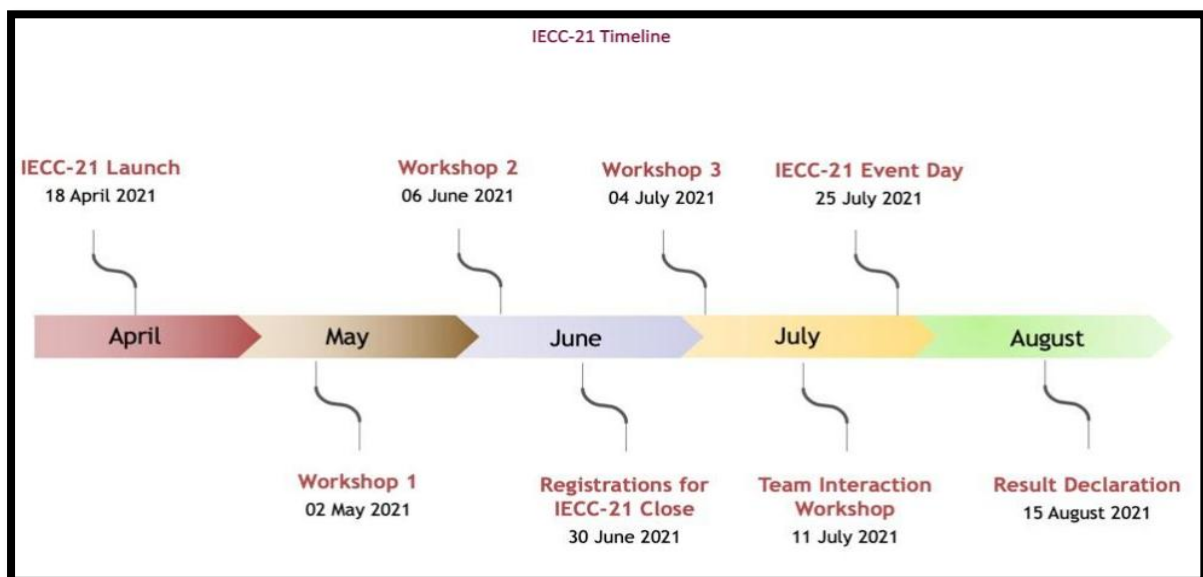
