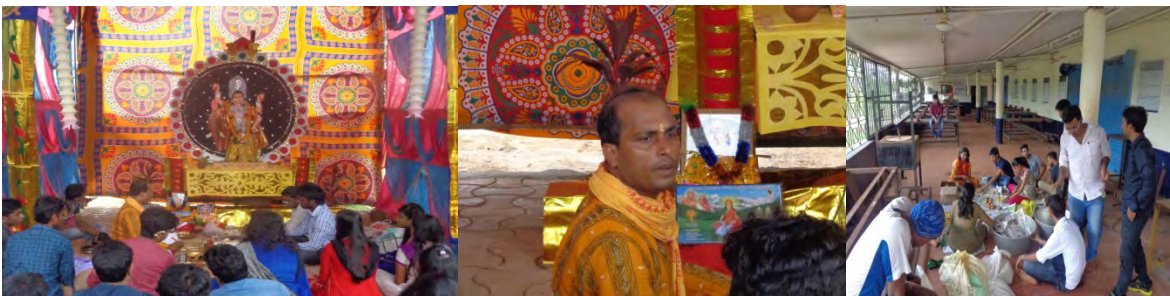
GANESH PUJA CELEBRATION:-

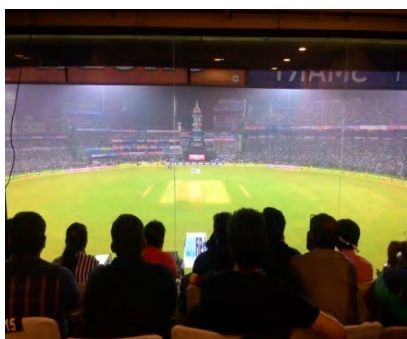
CSR REPORT (OCT – DEC 2015)

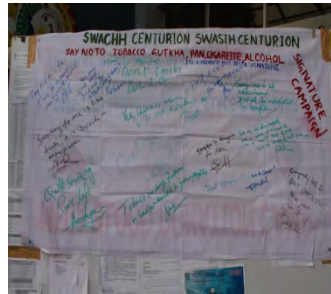

Centurions at 12th Dhauli-Kalinga Mahotsav:

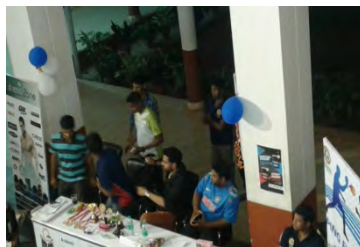
A group of students witnessed the 12th Dhauli - Kalinga Mahotsav on 6th & 7th February at the foothills of Dhauli.
