ABOUT CSR PROGRAMME

It is part of our curriculum that all students of Centurion University of Technology and Management will now be required to participate in the Culture, Sports, and Responsibility (CSR) program during their studies at CUTM w.e.f. 2011-12 academic year. The program gives students an opportunity to learn from the experience of doing real tasks beyond the classroom, related to Culture (student life/creative pursuits), Sports (activities for Physical Fitness) and Responsibility (activities for the benefit of the community or the environment).

Each student is required to complete a total of 30 hours of CSR activities each academic year*. This should include 10 hours of Culture, 10 hours of Sports and 10 hours of Responsibility. After completing of an activity, the Faculty supervisor must sign this record booklet. Only students who have completed the required hours (each activity will be minimum of 1 hour and maximum of 8 hours) of CSR, are eligible to pass that academic year.

At the end of the Centurion University degree, the CSR grade will be reflected in the final Grade Sheet and the student will receive the CSR Booklet listing all of the CSR activities he has completed. This can be used for his/her Resume. Information about student clubs, meetings, including details of Faculty-In-Charge, their contact, and CSR updates are displayed on the CSR Activity Information Board on campus. Student can ask any faculty member to supervise the activity and sign the CSR Booklet indicating that the hours have been completed.

TYPES OF ACTIVITIES

Students are strongly encouraged to plan and initiate their own ideas, and collaborate with other students to create projects they find interesting and worthwhile. The activities below are merely examples. Generally, projects should be pre-approved by the chosen supervisor.

Examples of "Culture" activities:

- Working on CUTM student Newsletter, Wall Magazine, and Annual Magazine, .
- Organising/participating in dance, music or drama events.
- Preparing artistic works (e.g. murals) for beautification of CUTM.
- Participating in any event organised by the clubs under cultural activities.
- Painting and Photography etc.....

Examples of "Sports" activities:

- Participating in individual and team sports of the Institute
- Taking part in sporting expeditions.
- Participating in Health Club/Yoga Club.

- Participating / organising any adventurers' activities.
- Organising a college marathon/other sporting event etc.....

Examples of "Responsibility" activities:

- Any activities which benefit the community or environment.
- Plantation inside or outside CUTM.
- Visiting and helping in hospitals or orphanages.
- Blood donation camp.
- Organising Health check up camp.
- Save environment from pollution camp.
- Educational camp for population control.
- Organise disaster service camp.
- Socio-economic survey.
- Take emergency relief measures to the victims of natural disaster.
- Development of the sense of integration and friendliness.
- Volunteering with local NGOs, or coming up with your own social/environmental project in a group of students and working on it.
- Youth Red Cross activities.
- Fund raising for social/environmental projects etc.....

Students are welcomed to submit their new ideas, projects, and proposals to csr.cit@cutm.ac.in (CIT), csr.pkd@cutm.ac.in (JITM & CSREM). Any queries, suggestions and clarifications regarding the program can be obtained from the Professor In-Charge, CSR / Dean, Student Affairs.

Most importantly, the CSR program provides a refreshing counterbalance to academic activities. It is an opportunity to have fun, get to know your fellow students and do something innovative and try new experiences.

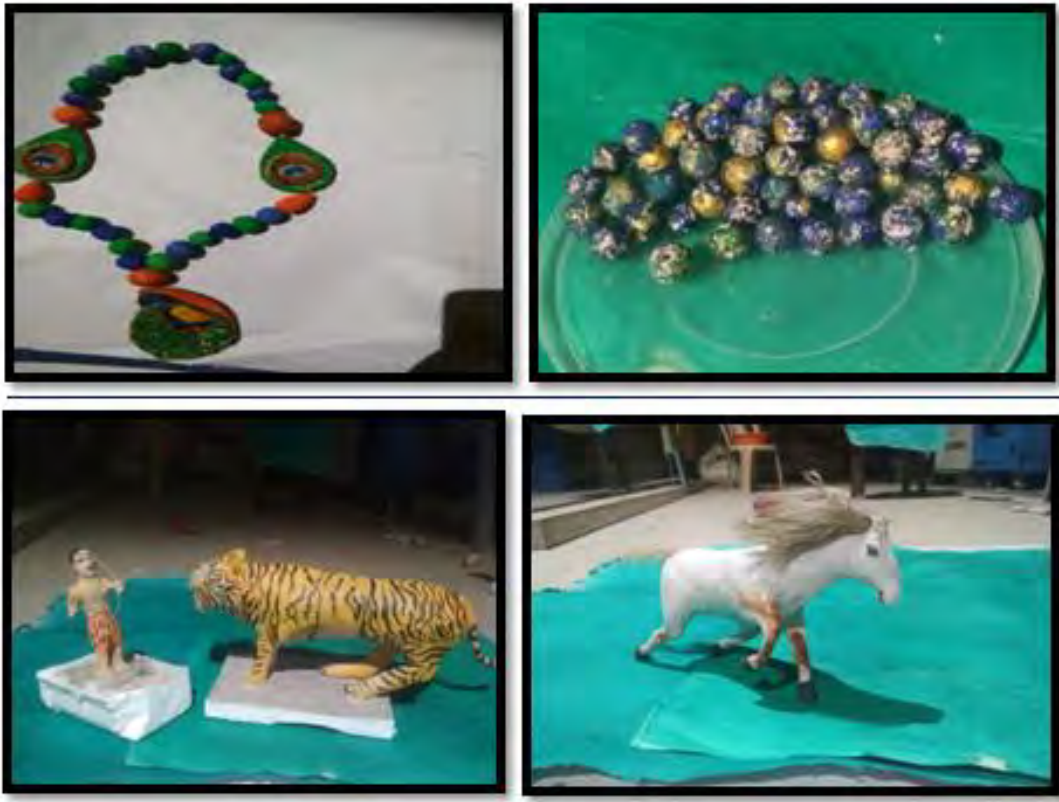

This year, on 2nd October, the whole World celebrated the 150th birth anniversary of Mahatma Gandhi. Mahatma Gandhi's birth anniversary is celebrated every year as Gandhi Jayanti to commemorate his ideals of peace and non-violence as well as his immense contribution to India's freedom struggle. Series of Awareness program on "ILL EFFECTS OF DRUG ABUSE" for Hostellers'

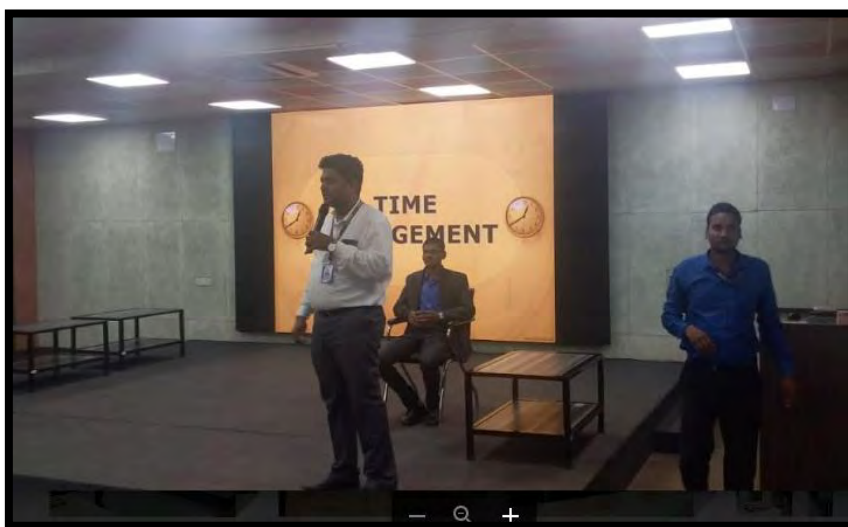
Date: Mar 13, 2020,



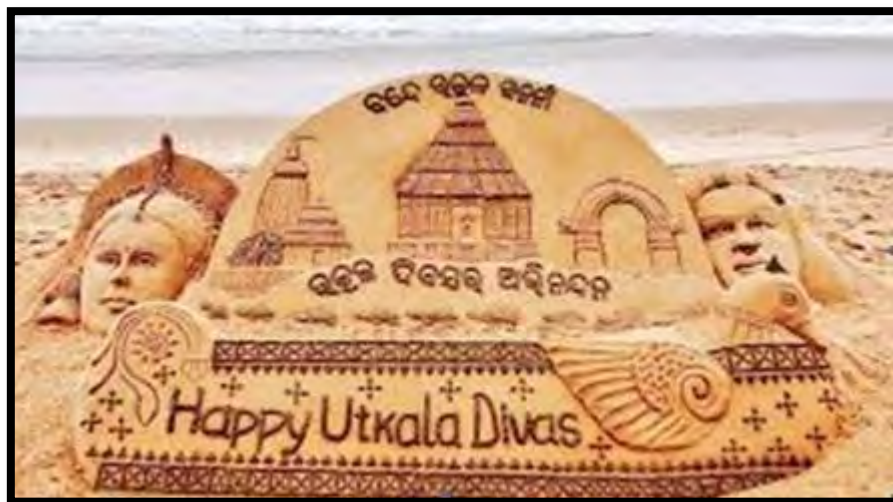
Wishing You all a Happy Utkala Dibas – Odisha Day @ 1st April!

Odisha Day (Utkala Dibas) is celebrated on 1st April in Odisha in the memory of the formation of the state as a separate province (Swatantra Pradesh) on 1 April, 1936. After losing its complete political identity in 1568 following the defeat and demise of the last Hindu king Mukunda Dev, Odisha lost its complete political identity in 1568.

To regain our pride Odia people revolt in the leadership of Utkala Gouraba Madhusudan Das, Utkala Mani Gopabandhu Das, Maharaja Krushna Chandra Gajapati, Pandita Nilakantha Das, Fakir Mohan Senapati, Gangadhar Meher, Basudeba Sudhaladeba, Radhanath Ray, Bhubanananda Das, A. P. Patro and many others. They founded Utkal Sammilani and fought for three decades and their effort resulted in the formation of a politically separate state under British rule on linguistic basis on 1st April 1936.

The newly formed Odisha consisted of six districts as Cuttack, Puri, Baleswar, Sambalpur, Koraput and Ganjam having its capital in Cuttack. John Austin Hubback took oath of office and became the first Governor of Orissa Province.

This Year we are not able to observe the Day on campus due to the lockdown. Let us think about the sacrifices made by our ancestors being at home.



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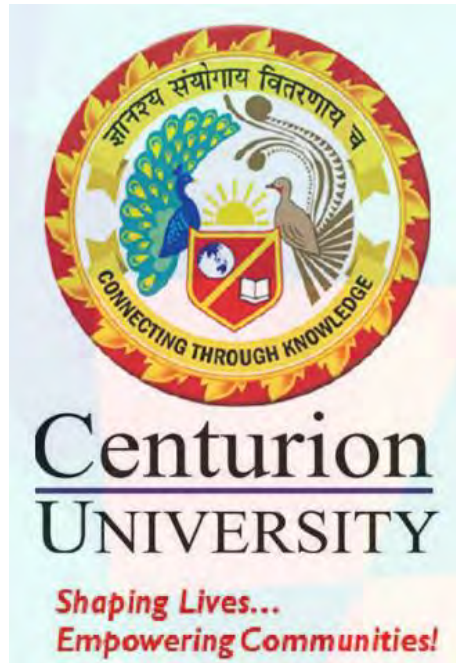
