


NATIONAL CADET CORPS NATIONAL CORPS


Awards Ceremony was successfully held on August 2, 2020.



As the students are to be graduated and going to step into a different phase of their lives, they




Utkal Divas or Utakala Dibasha was celebrated on April 1 every year to remember the formation of the Odisha state after a struggle to be recognized as an independent state.

movement are Utkala Gouraba, Madhusudan Das, Utkala Mani, Gopabandhu Das, Fakir Mohan Senapati, Pandita Nilakantha Das, King Krushnachandra Gajapati and many others.


HARSHO MOHAN CHATTORAJ


