Minutes of Meeting

The meeting of IQAC Cell, Centurion University was held and the following resolutions were taken by the Board;

- 1. It was decided to introduce foster parents systems. In this process each faculty will be attached with a group of students with their personal details and current performance. The foster parent will meet at least once in a week to keep a track of his class attendance and academic performance. Mentoring facility shall be provided to all students and the performance report will be shared to the parents. In each semester parents meeting will be conducted in the campus to seek their support and suggestion.
- 2. Tutorial classes shall be conducted every week for slow learners.
- 3. Every student will be encouraged to participate in CSR activities of the University and the grade shall be reflected in final degree transcript.
- 4. Every department will conduct workshop for designing session plan for theory subject and Lab plan for the subject offered in Labs.



- 5. The University will make a policy for Summer Immersion Programme for faculty members. During summer faculty can spend 15 to 30 days in an organization/institution to gain real time experience.
- 6. Communication courses will be given more thrust to develop language skills of students
- 7. It was proposed to create Anti Ragging Cell in the University at all campuses and necessary information are to be displayed at important location of the campus for visibility. Any grievance is reported the disciplinary committee has to address immediately.
