Minutes of Meeting

The meeting of IQAC Cell, Centurion University was held and the following resolutions were taken by the Board;

- 1. University will establish a Research Cell to support and encourage research activities by the faculty members. A seed money as research grant shall be provided to the faculty on the recommendation of University Research Committee.
- 2. HoDs of each department are authorized to engage external faculty of repute to teach part/full courses in visiting mode with approval of concerned Deans of schools
- 3. University will encourage faculty to visit industry/institutions and will invite resource person to visit our campus and interact with our students and faculty as a part institute-industry interface.
- 4. It was decided to develop e-content for all subjects and that will be loaded in tablet pc for student's use. E-content will have PPT, handouts, additional study materials, sample



- question, videos etc. Faculty members will refer these materials for teaching and evaluation.
- 5. University will encourage students to design and make prototype models as a part of projects.
- 6. The University will constitute Senior Management Team (STM) to formulate strategy, action plan and execute the vision and mission of the University.
- 7. The members agreed to make an Energy audit in both the campuses and to create awareness for minimum consumption of power, water and to make the campus green with more plantations. Campus Estate Managers will take lead with the support of faculty and students. CSR Coordinators will make drive for creating awareness.
- 8. Facility shall be created to preserve rain water in both the campuses and it should be ready by coming rainy season.
- 9. The necessary infrastructure to be developed for solid waste management of the campus and must be in function within a year.
