Minutes of Meeting

The meeting of IQAC Cell, Centurion University was held and the following resolutions were taken by the Board;



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- 1. The annual academic audit report of both the campus was presented and discussed. Members expressed their satisfaction over academic activities, students discipline and pre-placements activities
- 2. Considering the input standards of students and expectation of industry it was decided to start a "Life Skill Development Programme(LSD)" from semester-1. A curriculum will be designed to offer in each semester. Prof. D. N. Rao and Prof. Kalyan Banerjee will take lead for the drive to meet 200+ placements in year 2014. Internal faculty members will be engaged to guide and help students to practice the training materials to be developed in-house. Periodic progress review of each student will be done. Foster Parents support will be taken to counsel the students to take active part in LSD programme. The regular slot will be allocated in semester time-table.
- 3. Women Harassment Cell will be created under the leadership of Dr. Smita Mishra Panda. The cell will constitute the committee and operate in all campuses of the University. Prof. Sibakripa Bose will extend support in constituting the cell as per the Supreme Court Guideline and the cell will be operating with immediate effect. Awareness programme shall be conducted for all students, faculty and staff of the University. The Cell will be empowered to address all the grievances filed under this act.
- 4. Members welcome the collaboration made with "Sports Education and Development Australia(SEDA)" to develop sports, fitness, wellness and lifestyle that focus on applied learning and vocational skills.
- 5. It was proposed to include disaster management and environment management courses into all programmes of the University
