Quality Policy

The Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) was formulated on 1st July 2012 to design, monitor and assess the quality parameters in academic and administrative functions of Centurion University of Technology & Management (CUTM). IQAC of CUTM reviews and develops a system of conscious, regular and catalytic action to improve the teaching learning process, administrative performance, the evaluation procedure and the quality improvement of students and faculty. Internal auditing of the Institute, faculty and staff members is regularly done by the IQAC for continuous improvement.

The Senior Management Team (SMT) of the University is integral to the IQAC. The full composition of the IQAC is provided below. Its function is to collect feedback from internal and external stakeholders, monitoring and reviewing the impact of policies/activities, building capacity, making future action plan and assigning responsibility to individuals and teams. Each constituent campus also has an IQAC body that is responsible for determining its goal and methods to achieve it, periodically monitor and review all activities, build internal competency and evaluate the outcome.

Objectives

- To develop a system for conscious, consistent and catalytic action to improve the University's academic and administrative performance

- to promote measures for institutional functioning towards quality enhancement through internalization of quality culture and institutionalization of best practices



Strategies

The strategies of IQAC are based on the principles of

1. ensuring timely, efficient and progressive performance improvement of academic, administrative and financial tasks
2. promoting quality of academic and research programmes
3. monitoring equitable access to academic programmes and their affordability for various sections of society
4. focusing on optimization and integration of the latest methods and techniques of teaching and learning through “on-going and after action reviews”
5. developing objectivity and credibility of evaluation procedures
6. ensuring the adequacy, maintenance and functioning of the support structure and services

7. sharing research and discoveries through networking with other institutions in India and abroad
8. consistently updating the universities systems and procedures based on national and international best practices

Functions

IQAC is based on the following major functions

1. development and application of quality benchmarks/parameters for various academic and administrative activities of the university
2. creation of a learning-centred environment to enhance quality education
3. promotion of professional growth of faculty members through facilitating opportunities for them to enhance their knowledge and skills for effective delivery of teaching and learning process
4. provision for feedback from students, parents and other stakeholders of the institution on quality-related institutional processes
5. dissemination of information on various quality parameters for higher education
6. organization of inter and intra institutional workshops and seminars on quality related themes and promotion of quality circles
7. documentation of the various programmes/activities leading to quality enhancement
8. acting as a nodal agency of the university for coordinating quality-related activities, including adoption and dissemination of the best practices
9. development and maintenance of institutional database through MIS for the purpose of maintaining and enhancing institutional quality
10. development of Quality Culture in the university
