I. Targets



Community Engagement

Centurion University engages itself with low-income communities and is an equal opportunity employer and provides entrepreneurship opportunities. The manifestation of the same is economic growth which reduces conflicts and ensures peace. In a span of three years, 10000 youth were trained in various life-skills developments. The University targets to train an additional 2000 youth in the year 2023.



Enabling Ecosystem

Centurion University provides an enabling ecosystem through good governance. It also caters to the diverse needs of the students and employees. The University executes this through different committees and it targets to make the flow of information automated by 2023 and reduce the dispensation time from one week to three days.



Setting Up a Law School

Centurion university is setting up a Memorandum of Understanding with National Law University(NLU), Odisha. It targets to establish a law school in mentorship with NLU by 2023.



Striving Equality

Centurion University aims to be affordable, equitable, and inclusive in a bid to address equality it has equalized its fee for domestic and international students. It has 178 international students from different countries including war-torn countries. It targets to admit students from economically backward African nations by 2023.



Blood Donation

Centurion University in collaboration which different organizations like Red Cross organizes Blood Donation Camps within its campuses. In the year 2021, 228 units of blood were collected. The University targets to collect 500 units of blood.

Centurion University has its campuses located in Rural and Aspirational districts of Odisha. Its first campus was established in a place named Paralekhmundi which had suffered from left wing extremism. The inception of an educational institute there had slowly changed the economical dynamics of the place. The place had finally turned to be an aspirational district and the University itself is an employer of plethora of people from the local community. It is noteworthy that it is the only higher educational institute which has facility of education from school to doctorate. The campus had served as a facility during disasters like shelter home during cyclones and epidemics. During COVID the University had transformed it`s facility into a hospital which had catered to the local community.

The University ensures transparency at all echelons and has different policies at place. It strives to reduce the throughput time of information flow. Similarly, adhering to Government legislations there are committees at place for protection of interests of reserved classes, women and differently abled children.
